

ECO ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Another student group has entered the master's class for the period October-December 2016.



On 26th Jul 2016 a meeting – discussion ***“Approaches for design of university courses in an interdisciplinary discourse”*** took place. It was organized by the Institute for the Study of Societies and Knowledge at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences (ISSK-BAS) and Faculty “Business and management” at University of Ruse “Angel Kanchev”.

The event was part of a project “Training in eco entrepreneurship in 3 universities outside the capital” of ISSK, financed by the Institute for ecological research (Heidelberg) and the German federal ecological foundation (DBU). 15 university lecturers, experts and researchers were present and conducted an interactive discussion through the methods “Scientific coffee” and “Focus group” regarding:

- ✓ Construction of attractive and efficient training in an interdisciplinary environment by the example of the eco entrepreneurship and the entrepreneurship for sustainable development;
- ✓ The challenges before the higher education regarding the learning process and the competences of the participants in it.

The opinions, conclusions, ideas and recommendations that were stated have become a good basis for adaptation and improvement of the approaches for learning at the university and sharing good practices for managing up to date challenges in the work of the academic representatives.

On 15th Jun 2016 3 of the teams from the master's class on eco entrepreneurship presented their finished work – start-up conceptions, a portfolio analysis, a reviewing report. The ideas are focused on using the energy from wind, creating plantations of ethereal plants and creating a consultant activity in the sphere of ecological corporate social responsibility.

During the event the teams of students from different faculties presented their ideas, answered questions and discussed key aspects with representatives of the field, mentors and academic lecturers who were attending.

The successful coverage of the criteria for graduating the 3-month training in the master's class was approved through an individual certificate for passed training that was given.
